It was featured at the 1851 Crystal Palace Exhibition. There would never have been a joker or box but it possibly had a wrapper.</p> <p>De La Rue Co. Minimum 110</p>			
<p>Lot 51 Richardson Round Deck 1875 USA</p> <p>52+J EX OB3 This edition of "Globe Round Cards" was improved by adding the suit color to the king's crown, the queen's hair and the jack's cap. Diamonds are yellow, clubs are green. Box lid is taped; a 3c and 2c stamp are on the side of the box.</p> <p>I. W. Richardson Hochman O12 Minimum 90</p>

<p>Lot 55 New Index Deck 1926 USA</p> <p>52+J MS OB1 Nice mint-sealed deck (with 10-cent tax stamp). New Index was created by USPC to prevent revokes in bridge. The spades and hearts show suit symbols above index number, while clubs and diamonds are in normal place. Outer box has minor soiling.</p> <p>USPC Hochman NR8 Minimum 20</p>			
<p>Lot 56 New Zealand Souvenir Deck 1905 Bavaria</p> <p>52+J VG No Box Rare deck in a very different style than most souvenir decks; pips have triplicate indices, photos cover 1/3 of card. Each card has a photo of New Zealand location or view of native inhabitants, culture. Cards have edge soil; joker has a crease.</p> <p>Muir & Moodie Minimum 130</p>
